### What is VRG?

The Veterans Relief Grant (VRG) is a nonrepayable fund offered by the Home Deployment Project to qualified veterans at risk of losing their homes.

### What is the criteria to qualify?

- If you are an Honorably Discharged Veteran of the US Armed Forces
- If you are currently in the process of foreclosure or eviction
- If you do not have the financial means to recover on your own
- If you cannot provide the basic needs for yourself and immediate family
- If you live in the 50 United States or its territories
